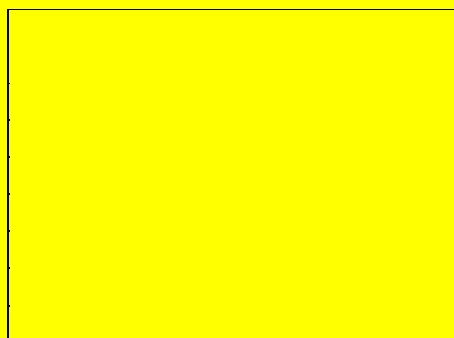

All participants are required to walk the course and if not competent to cope with the specification and conditions, withdraw from the competition.

Entry is conditional upon acceptance of these conditions:

1. Entry Fee must be paid before riding:
 - a. Open competitors (except PCV members) who have insurance must complete the Liability Declaration form but are exempt from payment of the Day Participant fee. Riders without approved insurance will be required to pay an additional Day Participant fee.
 - b. All competitors except for members of relevant user groups will be required to pay a \$7 facility fee per horse for entry to the IR Robertson Reserve.
 - c. All riders will be required to pay a \$15 medical levy to cover the new PCA medical requirements.
2. No refunds after closing date except with vet or medical certificate. An admin fee of \$10 will be deducted.
3. Entries are accepted in order of receipt until sections are full. In the event that excess entries are received a waiting list will be created and advised. Late entries will only be accepted at committee discretion if places are available. The organising committee reserves the right to refuse entries without explanation.
4. Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that PCV rules apply and acceptance of these rules.
 - a. PCV club member cards must be inspected at the secretary's office.
5. The organising committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition; divide any class; alter times; refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.
6. Competitors may ride more than one horse, subject to the conditions of PCV Handbook of By-laws multiple horse rules. However please note times may clash and it is the rider's responsibility to notify stewards and manage the times accordingly.
7. Complying helmets must be worn, spot checks may occur.
8. Gear Check: Note PCA gear check rules apply and a gear check is required for all riders before competing in the first event. Any rider failing to attend and comply with uniform or gear requirements risks disqualification. (Note: only one gear check is required for both events unless the gear has been changed.)
9. Horses must be at least four years of age, no stallions, colts or rigs.
10. PCV Alcohol Policy applies.
11. Queries, protests, horse abuse, rules as per the PCV Handbook of By-Laws.
12. This event will comply with the PCV Biosecurity and Covid-19 Guidelines which are current at the time of the event.
13. Neither the organising committee of this competition nor the PCV accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property.
14. Lunging only permitted in allocated area.
